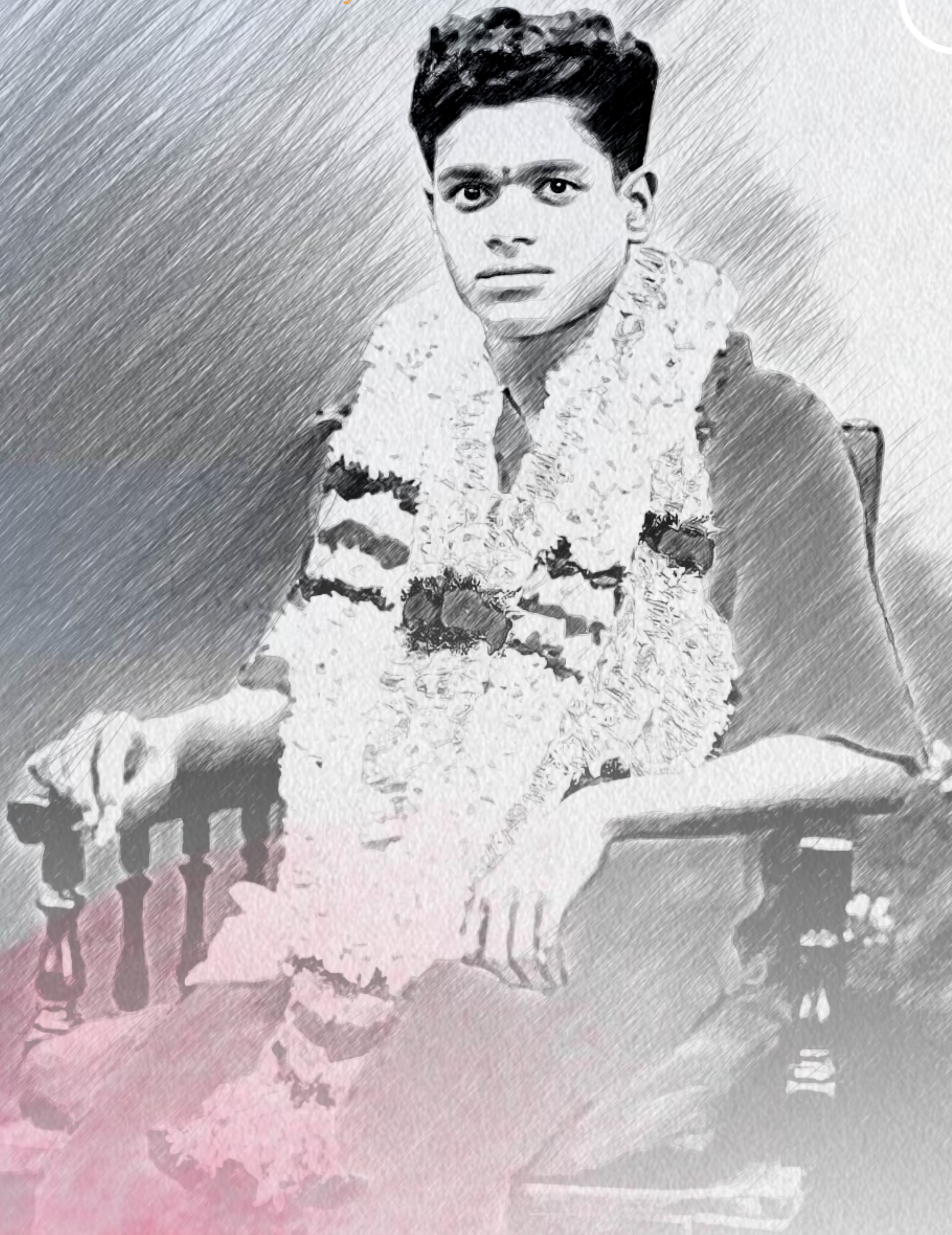


BE DIVINE...SEE AND SERVE DIVINITY
