# Respect and Love for Guru, Parents, Children

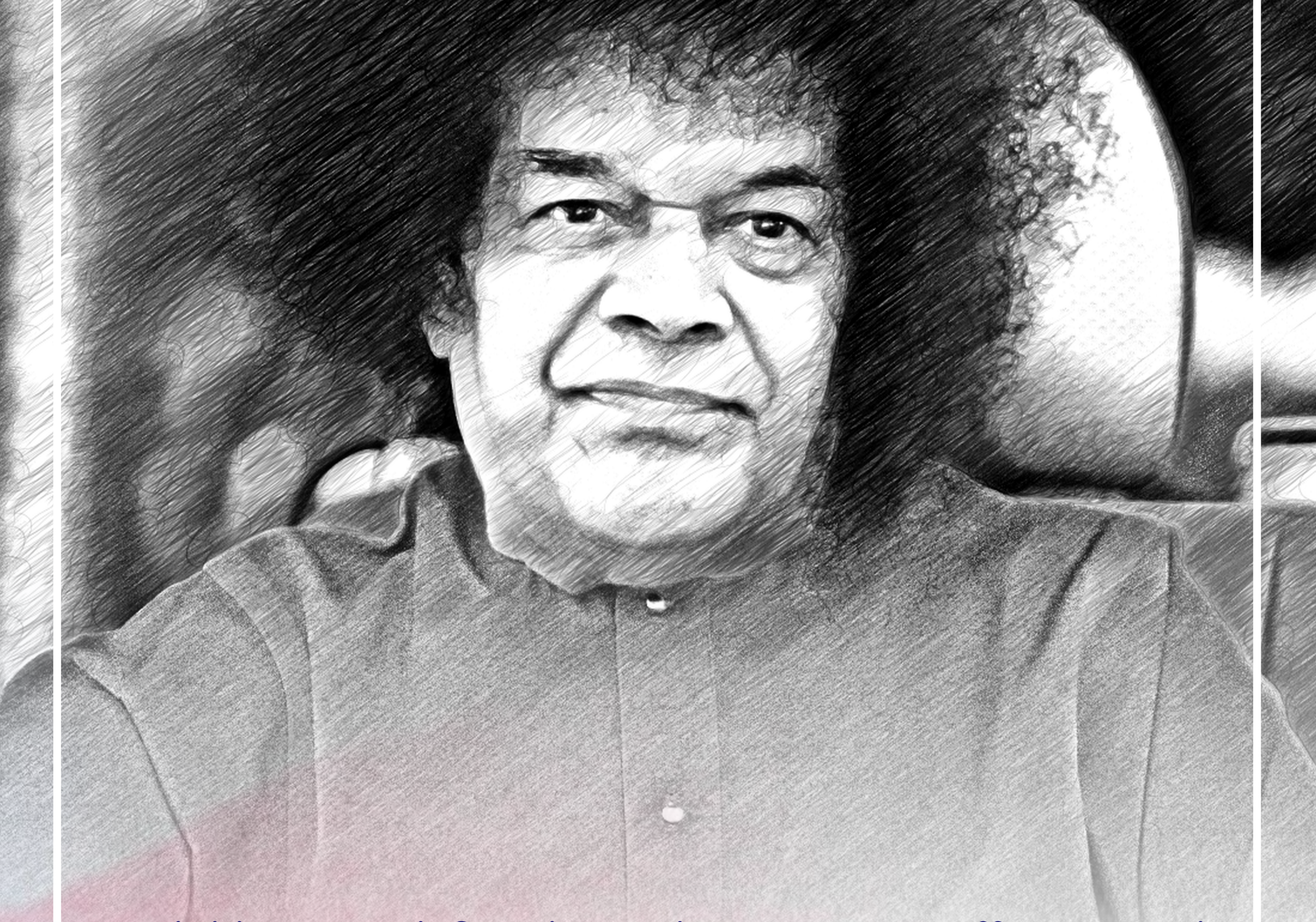


**BE DIVINE...SEE AND SERVE DIVINITY**
